Bel Fullana (Mallorca, 1985) holds a degree in Fine Arts, specializing in Painting, from the University of Barcelona (UB). She has exhibited internationally in both solo and group exhibitions in cities such as Berlin, London, Los Angeles, New York, Miami, São Paulo, Bangkok, Sydney, Seoul, Taipei, Athens, Copenhagen, and Porto.

Her notable solo exhibitions include Cemetery Head (Freight+Volume, New York, 2024), Sayonara Baby (PIERMARQ*, Sydney, 2024), Tractor Buddy (Es Baluard Museum of Contemporary Art of Palma, Mallorca, 2024), and PutiPandi (Freight+Volume, New York, 2022). Selected group exhibitions include Technostalgia (Allouche Gallery, New York/Los Angeles, 2024), XOXO (Delimbo Gallery, Seville, Spain, 2024), and BADASS (Dopeness Art Lab, Taipei, 2021), among others.

She has also participated in international art fairs, presenting her work in key contemporary art platforms such as CAN Art Ibiza, KIAF Seoul, ARCO Madrid and Lisbon, Untitled Miami, Zona MACO Mexico, Art Rotterdam, Sunday London, Ch.ACO Chile, as well as Enter Art Fair, Art Herning, and Art Copenhagen in Denmark.

Her work is held in collections including the Es Baluard Museum Foundation (Mallorca), Casa MER Collection (Segovia), Marquez Art Projects (Miami), and the Mecenas Collection (Chile), among others.
